Principal's report:

Mr. Birkenbergs went over an updated list of school generated funds in detail. List included numbers are inclusive of CSC commitments.

Funds generated: Photography brings in \$300 Milk \$1500 lunch lady \$500 Approx.: \$2300 total

Biggest fundraiser for our school is the Pizza fundraiser that is on a weekly order therefore the pizza company gives us a cheaper rate.

Charitable Share life and terry fox total does not go to the school but directly to the charities.

We have a total of approx. \$17, 500 in funds per year. CSC will also have amounts generated through their initiatives.

As a school we don't make money on field trips

Approx. total revenue generated at 39,000

Jump rope for heart is a fundraiser but was not included in report as all monies are collected by them directly.

School expenses-- major is athletics... \$200/\$300 per event ... all events paid by school funds so students don't pay to participate.

Theology budget is \$3500 as we try to invest in our faith and community.

We will be doing advent mass again this year. Therefore, we will be bussing the staff and students again and will absorb the cost of this.

School clubs \$2500 to allow to participate without a cost to the students Eco Schools \$1500 banking fees \$250

Graduation \$1000 -refreshments, gifts any additional costs
Retreat for lent - cost for activities
Spend approx. \$1000 during the year to help families within our own community.
School presentations such as Brave program- total was about \$1200
Healthy school incentives

Mrs. Silva asked why we had a new photographer this year as some parents had expressed concerns regarding the lack of options this year. Mr. Birkenbergs said that the change was because they supply the virtue certificates. The cost is similar to the other companies and commission is same flat rate went with edge. Council to gather feedback regarding how parents feel about the change and come back to the photographer with some ideas on changes that can be made to offer more options to the community.
